# **Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“MSA”)**

## **Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement**

### **Financial Year Ending: 30th September 2025**

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the ‘Modern Slavery Act 2015’. It sets out the steps that Emptor Plus Ltd has taken during the financial year to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in its business or within its main supply chain activities.

#### **Our Business**

We are a small micro-sized UK-based consulting business. We operate with two directors’ and do not employ additional staff.

Our business service provision is focused on supply chain consulting and advisory support. This spans power, energy, and defence sectors. Our activities are geared towards SMEs, industry learning enterprises, and key support organisations.

#### **Our Commitment**

At Emptor Plus Ltd, we take a zero-tolerance approach to slavery and human trafficking.

Accordingly, we are committed to acting ethically, with integrity and transparency in all business dealings, and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to safeguard against modern slavery.

#### **Our Primary Supply Chain**

Our primary supply chain is aligned to operational business needs. It is limited in scope and is regularly monitored. It comprises professional service providers, including accountancy, banking, legal, IT provision and support. It is predominantly UK-based and in all cases operates within regulated environments, with a low modern slavery and human trafficking risk.

#### **Broader Risk Assessment**

Recognising the nature of our business activities and corresponding supply chain, we assess the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking to be low. We do not operate in the high-risk sectors or geographies where modern slavery is known to be an issue or concern.

### Policies Due Diligence and Controls

In line with the type and size of our operation, we adopt a proportionate approach to due diligence. This includes:

- Engaging reputable suppliers with established professional standards
- Monitoring transparencies relating to modern slavery
- Checking for compliance with applicable laws and ethical practices
- Maintaining full awareness of modern slavery risks when entering new supplier relationships
- Continuing third party certified training, on an annualised basis.

### Ongoing Review and Further Steps

We will continue to review our practices and supply relationships. We will do this periodically to ensure they remain appropriate to the size and nature of our business. Should our operations expand, we will enhance our controls accordingly.
