## **Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement**

### **Financial Year Ending: 30th September 2025**

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015'. It sets out the steps that Emptor Plus Ltd has taken during the financial year to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in its business or supply chain activities.

#### **Our Business**

We are a small micro-sized UK-based consulting business. We operate with two directors' and do not employ additional staff.

Our service provision focuses on supply chain consulting and advisory support, across power, energy, and defence sectors, and is primarily geared towards SME'.

#### **Our Commitment**

At Emptor Plus Ltd, we take a zero-tolerance approach to slavery and human trafficking.

Accordingly, we are committed to acting ethically, with integrity and transparency in all business dealings, and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to safeguard against modern slavery.

#### **Our Supply Chains**

Our supply chain is limited in scope. It primarily comprises professional service providers, including accountancy, banking, legal, and for IT support. Our suppliers are typically UK-based and operate in regulated environments. We therefore consider the risk of modern slavery within our business and supply chain to be low.

#### **Broader Risk Assessment**

Recognising the nature of our business activities and corresponding supply chain, we assess the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking to be low. We do not operate in the high-risk sectors or geographies where modern slavery is known to be an issue or concern.

## **Policies Due Diligence and Controls**

In line with the scale of our operations, we adopt a proportionate approach to due diligence. This includes:

- Engaging reputable suppliers with established professional standards
- Expecting compliance with applicable laws and ethical practices
- Maintaining awareness of modern slavery risks when entering new supplier relationships

## **Ongoing Review and Further Steps**

We will continue to review our practices and supply relationships. We will do this periodically to ensure they remain appropriate to the size and nature of our business. Should our operations expand, we will enhance our controls accordingly.
